The "Industrial Association" did want to have a more showing appearance. To point out the industrial theme we took metal as a basis material in most areas. You can find it in the furniture, doors, staircase and cladding. In addition we worked with quite natural colors like white and cream and the material glass.

As it is a renovation of a 20 year old building, we broke down the windows, in order to create more transparency and space. We opened the cladding and added the cube to achieve full transparency and strengthen the outside appearance. We also designed a balcony as an extension of the inner space.

For the recognition value the "IV"-Logo is

written on the cladding. On the ground floor little metal "IV"-Logos are hanging from the ceiling for the pedestrians to see.

As the three floors of the Industrial Association should be a connected space, the interior staircase heads one up to the big conference room. There we again worked with a lot of transparency, so that we get the light shining from east to west. We also put an accent to the great view onto the Pöstlingberg, an emblem of Linz.

The steering committee room is next to the "come together" area on the ground floor and separated by a partition wall. In case of a big event it is possible to interconnect the two

areas and transfer it into one big foyer. Behind the parked partition wall is enough room to store the entire interior from the steering committee room.

In the pre zone of the first floor, there is a lounge area with Moroso-seating on a cow coat, as well as felt lampshades.

The internal offices are located in the second floor and are also designed as an open floor plan. Only furniture is dividing the space. For acoustic reasons we added area covered curtains.

At the entrance zone of the office space on the third floor an image and a meeting point with an integrated bench is welcoming you.
